## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURAL RESOURCES ("MDAR") HEREBY GIVES NOTICE OF A GENERAL HEARING, PURSUANT TO M.G.L. C.30A, § 2 and 950 CMR 20.04 which requires the Commissioner of the Department of Agricultural Resources to hold a public hearing for the permanent adoption of 330 CMR 30.00 Animal Rescue and Shelter Regulations. The regulation is designed to protect the Commonwealth's domestic animal population from the introduction of infectious disease via imported animals as well as ensure that only healthy animals are placed in peoples' homes as pets.
