87-01-01-01. Organization of board of veterinary medical examiners.

- History. The 1895 legislative assembly passed a law entitled "Qualifications of Veterinarians" which requires the governor to appoint a board of veterinary examiners, known as the state board of veterinary medical examiners.
 - 2. **Board membership.** The board consists of five members (three veterinarians, one veterinary technician, and one public member) who serve three-year terms, with no more than two terms expiring each year.

Compensation of members of board. A member of the board may receive for each day during which that member is actually engaged in the performance of the duties of office a per diem in the amount of one

- hundred twenty-five dollars.
